

## ***Dunlop Destiny 2025 / 2026***

The Circuit Excel Racing Association (CERA) and Wildan 13 / Dunlop Motorsport are pleased to announce the continuation of the Dunlop Destiny Program following its successful outcomes in 2024/2025. For the 2025/2026 season, CERA will introduce a new selection process whereby each State will be allocated one position, and the respective State clubs will select a driver who meets the following criteria:

- Overall driver's race performance
- Driver's overall temperament on and off the track
- Drivers' social media presence/exposure
- Ability to absorb coaching comments and improve their driving outcomes
- Driver must compete in all rounds of a State Series conducted under Motorsport Australia Group 3E – Circuit Excel – Technical Regulations
- On-track driving standards
- Must be between the ages of 14 to 25 years as of December 31, 2025

The selected driver from each state, along with selected wildcards, will attend an evaluation day in 2026 for coaching and evaluation. CERA retains final discretion over the drivers selected by the States, as well as the wildcard positions.

This program celebrates exceptional driving skills and emphasizes the importance of media presence, sportsmanship, and the ability to engage with fans on social media. It is designed to evaluate drivers comprehensively, ensuring that those who excel are awarded opportunities that could advance their racing careers.

The winner of this process will be offered a drive at a round of the Toyota 86 Scholarship Series in 2026.
